QUOTES

- Requests for quotes are sent to gcln@gcln.org.au and MUST include the estimated month the order will be collected.
- Quotes are valid for 30 DAYS from date of issue unless the stock is sold beforehand.
- Prices quoted are Wholesale.
- Minimum quantity for wholesale pricing is one full tray (40 plantsx50mm pot size) of each species, Mixed trays are sold at Retail price.
- Seedlings are grown in individual pots, but other types of containers may be available on request. A surcharge will apply.
- Plants may be grown from your own seed or from special Provenance, but a surcharge may apply.
- This list is the species that GCLN regularly grows in larger quantities, if you are looking for species not on this list please enquire, GCLN may already grow these in smaller quantities or, if propagating materials can be obtained at the correct time, GCLN can attempt to grow other species for you.

PLANT SPECIFICATIONS

- Any customer plant specifications MUST be included with the quote request.
- Any quote request with customer plant specifications MUST specify a pickup date, any change to this date after quoting will affect GCLN's ability to meet specifications.

SALES ORDERS

- By submitting your Order, you are agreeing to GCLN's Terms and Conditions.
- Plants are allocated on a first ordered, first supplied basis and are subject to availability.

INVOICES

- Once a quote has been accepted by the customer GCLN will issue a Deposit Invoice for 50% of the value of orders over \$500.00. Orders under this amount will incur one invoice only with the same payment terms as deposits.
- The Deposit Invoice trading terms are strictly 7 days from the date of Invoice unless prior arrangements are made with GCLN.
- Deposits are non-refundable.
- GCLN will contact you prior to your estimated pickup date to confirm a date for pickup of your order. Once a date is confirmed GCLN will prepare your order for pickup. At the same time GCLN will issue an Invoice for the balance of payment, with payment terms strictly 7 days from the date of Invoice, or on collection.
- Your order will remain in the nursery until GCLN has received your final payment, may be varied by special agreement.

ORDER PICKUP AND CANCELLED ORDERS

- GCLN requires a minimum of 10 working days' notice prior to pick up of orders.
- Cancelled orders will forfeit the previously paid DEPOSIT.
- Orders not collected within 14 days of the due date (without contact) will attract a holding fee of \$5.00 per tray, per week for storage. While GCLN will care for the plants, GCLN accepts no responsibility for plant losses after the 14 days.
- Unless you contact GCLN in the interim, after 60 days the order will be declared 'abandoned' and return to stock.

RETURNS

- Due to plant quarantine protocols, there are no returns of plants after collection.

SHORTAGES

- In the event of stock shortages, GCLN reserves the right to:
- Offer substitute species, subject to agreement by the customer.
- Offer credit against any outstanding balance and/or against future orders. (NB Credit only remains available for the next season (1 year)).
- Refund the difference (by agreement).

POTS AND TRAYS

- Please return all pots and trays to recycling bins in our carpark.

GUARANTEE

- Plants are guaranteed to be true to labelled species, and FULL trays/numbers.
- GCLN will take reasonable, practical measures to eliminate weeds in the product at pickup.
