These screening plants ...

- will grow 3m x 2m or more
- have dense foliage
- will become denser with regular clipping/pruning
- will grow in most soils
- have habitat value for birds and other wildlife
- will block line-of-sight headlight glare and wind
- have attractive flowers and foliage
- are local to our area and thrive in our conditions
- wetland species will tolerate all soils except coastal
- coastal species will tolerate all soils except mud
- long-lived, tough and interesting
- are usually available at our nursery
